## Partnering for Impact

### 1. Why should community partners participate in Partnering for Impact-Consortial Publications?

RADx-UP values community partner feedback on opportunities and barriers for engaging underserved communities. Community partners in conjunction with RADx-UP funded projects continue to work together to increase COVID-19 testing at a local level. We want to continue this collaboration in the publications process also. By doing so, community partners will provide expertise in how the data from communities can be used to support COVID-19 research.

### 2. What roles can community partners play in the writing and editing process?

Community partners can serve in various roles and capacities including writing, reviewing/commenting, providing a community perspective, or performing statistical analysis. The RADx-UP Publications Policy provides additional guidance on the expectations for authorship. See policy linked [here](#).

### 3. Will the CDCC provide support and education to those who are new to manuscript writing?

Yes, the CDCC will have workshops, and other training materials, for community partners on how to look at the data dashboards, engaging ways to identify a research topic, and support on writing efforts for publications. ### 4. Can community partners introduce a research question on the Analysis Concept and Analysis Proposal forms without an academic lead?

Absolutely! If there is a research question that needs answering- introduce the idea on the [Analysis Concept form](#). The Analysis Concept submission provides the opportunity to present the idea to the consortium. By posting the Analysis Concept in *myRADx-UPhome* for two weeks, opportunities for shared support and collaboration are offered to projects and community members. The Analysis Proposal found on *myRADx-UPhome* will provide our statisticians guidance in what datasets will be helpful for your analysis.

### 5. What support will CDCC provide during the proposal and writing process?

**The CDCC will provide the following support during the process and welcome feedback from you:**

- Project Leader assigned to your Writing Team
- Zoom Links to facilitate collaboration and dedicated meeting times
- Shared collaboration folder with links for manuscript completion
- Support during writing team meetings to identify barriers and work to make connections with members of CDCC team as appropriate
- Statistician for consultation, dataset pulls, and if needed, data analysis.
- Workshop offerings
- Office Hours to meet with CDCC members as needed
